- 1. The fallen wall at the top of Berry Hill, Beer backing onto Barnard's Farm is now being replaced with a new wall.
- 2. Netting has been installed onto the western cliffs at Beer Beach to safeguard against rock falls onto Beer Beach and to slow down erosion.
- **3.** I have been supporting some local residents to be rehoused in social housing in Beer. A young family where the father works locally have been rehoused.
- **4.** The dangerous pothole just past Bunts Lane on the Beer to Seaton Road has been filled in by DCC Highways following my request to DCC.
- 5. I have been advocating for Seaton Gateway to be supported to remain open for business once essential electrical & safety work has been completed at Seaton Town Hall and there is a meeting next Wednesday 19 February at 6.30pm at The Old Picture House, Seaton to discuss supporting The Gateway. My wife and I will be attending this meeting.
- **6.** I have been advocating on behalf of a local resident in west Seaton regarding her concerns over The Chine and EDDC Environmental Health have informed me they are investigating the resident's concerns.
- 7. The next committee meeting for the Seaton & District Youth Group will be Thursday 27 February at 7pm at Item Drop, Seaton. The plan is for the youth group to commence first week in May.
